



## Eco-friendly cleaning products

### Vinegar, Bicarbonate of Soda, Lemon

Save money and be environmentally aware. Use Vinegar, Baking Soda and Lemon for cleaning around the home.

**White Wine Vinegar** - Can be used as disinfectant and for cleaning most surfaces.

**Do not use on wooden floors, marble, granite or porous natural stone and chrome.**

- **Tile Floors** - Mix ¼ cup of vinegar with 3 l Water
- **Softener:** Add 1 cup of White Vinegar to the final rinse.
- **Descale Coffee maker, Kettle, Steam Iron:** Run it with equal parts of water and vinegar. Halfway through the cycle turn it off. Let it stand for an hour. Complete the cycle. Rinse.
- **Microwave:** Place 1 cup of Vinegar and 1 cup of water in a bowl. Microwave on high for 10 minutes. Wipe the microwave.
- **Glass:** Mix 1 tablespoon of vinegar with 750 ml water in Spray bottle – Spray and wipe clean.
- **Mold:** Mix 1 tablespoon of vinegar with 750 ml water in Spray bottle – Spray on. Leave for 15 minutes and wipe clean.
- **Carpet Stains:** Rub light carpet stains with 2 tablespoons of Salt mixed with ½ cup of vinegar. Leave to dry. Vacuum.
- **Remove mineral deposits from Shower heads:** Place vinegar in a plastic bag and tie to the showerhead. Let it sit overnight. Rinse with water and wipe clean.

**Baking Soda** – odour removing properties and capable remove tough stains due to its abrasiveness.

- **Stainless steel sink:** Wet sink, sprinkle baking soda onto surface, scrub and rinse.
- **Bathroom cleaner:** Mix 1½ cup baking soda with ½ cup liquid soap and ½ cup of water in a bowl, until smooth. Add 2 tablespoons of vinegar. Pour into a 750ml Squir bottle. Squirt on the area to be cleaned. Scrub with sponge. Wipe with clean water.
- **Burnt food in Pots:** Sprinkle Baking Soda onto the burnt surface. Add warm water let it sit overnight. Clean in the morning.
- **Deoderise shoes and rugs:** Sprinkle Baking Soda into shoes or on rugs. Let it sit overnight. Vacuum.
- **Remove odours from food containers:** Rinse container with Baking Soda and water. Let sit overnight if smell persists.
- **Crayon Marks on walls:** Mix equal parts of Baking Soda and water to a paste. Apply to the marks. Let it sit for a while. Wipe clean.
- **General Surface Cleaning:** Add ½ cup of Baking Soda to 3liters of water.

**Lemon** – natural disinfectant and stain remover because of their acidity

- **Fridge:** Freshen up your fridge by placing half a fresh lemon in the fridge or a bowl with Baking Soda.
- **Stains:** Rub lemon juice into cutting boards or containers remove food stains.
- **Faucets:** Rub lemon juice onto faucets to remove lime scale. Let it sit overnight. Rinse.
- **Rust stains on clothing:** Apply lemon juice to stain rub in Cream of Tartar (be careful, as it is a natural bleaching agent)
- **Cleaning grout:** Mix lemon juice with 1 teaspoon Cream of Tartar to a paste. Scrub grout with mixture and an old toothbrush. Rinse with fresh water.
